



HOSPITALITY TRAINING ACADEMY AT THE DEAD SEA JORDAN

The Hospitality Training Academy located at both Crowne Plaza Jordan Dead Sea Resort and Spa and the Holiday Inn Resort will train young men and women in hotel related skills and build their career based on excellent professional standards. The Academy will support the local community in the Dead Sea area to access full-time jobs in the hospitality industry.

In close collaboration with the USAID Building Economic Sustainability through Tourism Project (BEST) and Amman Chamber of Commerce; the Hospitality Training Academy aims to provide youth with the technical and industry-related soft skills including English language and guest courtesy.

The Academy is equipped with state-of-the-art learning laboratories and training facilities. The program is delivered by professional trainers from hotel operations. Trainees will receive 12 months training in Food and Beverage Service, Food Production and Housekeeping Departments.

On completion, the trainees will select a career path and transit to the Pathways to Professionalism scheme for further training. Through Pathways to Professionalism they can progress their career with a national certificate.
